Dear neighbour,

Railway improvement work – Level Crossing and Signalling upgrades between Gomshall and Shalford Junction – from Saturday 18 February 2023 to March 2024

I'm writing to let you know that we need to renew life expired railway signalling assets and upgrade the level crossings at **Brook, Burrows Lane, Chilworth** and **Tangley** with modern and safer technology. This will reduce the risk by 97% at each location, building a safer and more resilient railway for passengers and railway neighbours.

We've also been working with the local authorities leading on traffic management plans to make sure appropriate signage will be in place when the level crossings are closed. Before we begin working, we'll set up a small compound and welfare facilities at Gomshall station and on the Albury Estate and we'll use site lighting for safety.

Every effort will be made to minimise excessive noise whilst this work is being carried out. Where possible, using specialist low noise equipment but unavoidable aspects of our work may cause some noise disturbance, both during the day and at night. There may be increased traffic in the area from delivery vehicles accessing the areas where we need to work. We're sorry in advance for the disruption and inconvenience this work will cause. **The table below summarises the level crossing road closures which will be in place in February.**

We'll be working at various locations in your local area until March 2024 as part of the railway improvement works on the North Downs Line. We will be in touch with you ahead of time as these works progress.		

Before we begin the wider project on the North Downs Line in your local area, we will be hosting two **community drop-in sessions for the local community**. This will provide an opportunity for the community to ask any questions and our project team to outline the required essential work. Additional various essential work taking place:

We're starting these early preparation works on Saturday 18 as the railway between Guildford and Dorking West will be out of service then, due to the 9-day blockade (line closure) between Farncombe and Petersfield being extended to Guildford. There will be an opportunity to implement other improvements and maintenance work, alongside the essential level crossing and signalling improvements, thus reducing some future disruptive access to the railway.

On **Sunday 19 February 2023** during the closure of the line, multiple contractors will carry out work between Gomshall and Shalford Junction as follows:
